This refers to your recent request for state approval to provide medical physics services under the Mammographic Quality Standards Act (MQSA) final rules and regulations, Section 900.12(a)(3)(ii)(B)(1).

We have determined that you meet the state requirements for medical physicists and you are approved to conduct evaluations of mammographic equipment and procedures under the Act.

Please remember you must continue to maintain documentation under Section 900.12(a)(3)(ii)(B)(1) verifying you have at least a bachelor's degree including at least ten semester hours of physics; under Section 900.12(a)(3)(ii)(B)(3) documentation of at least twenty mammography units you have evaluated; and your continuing mammography education credits under Section 900.12(a)(3)(iii), at each facility you survey.

This is to document the FDA requirements for individuals providing medical physics services under MQSA.

An individual must either be certified by an FDA - approved organization or be licensed or approved by a state to conduct inspections of mammography equipment.

Since you are certified by an FDA - approved organization (American Board of Medical Physics) and Mr. Mark Liddington (MD License No. 176) and Mr. Jack Olley (MD License No. 175) are licensed by the state of Maryland to inspect mammography equipment, all three of you would be qualified to provide medical physics services under MQSA.
